Ingredients

1 1/4 cup all-purpose flour

3/4 cup granulated sugar

1/4 cup packed brown sugar

1/2 tsp baking soda

1/4 tsp salt

1/2 tsp vanilla extract

1/2 tsp coconut extract

1/2 cup butter

I large egg

1 1/2 cups sweetened shredded coconut

2 tbsp butter


1/2 cup finely diced dried pineapple

In one bowl, combine flour, salt, and baking soda. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. In a larger bowl, cream the butter, sugar, and brown sugar together. Add in the vanilla and coconut extracts. Add one large egg. Begin mixing in the flour mixture slowly. Add the pineapple and coconut. Work the dough by hand until smooth. coconum. Work the acually by hand write smooth.

Form the dough into 1 Tosp balls and place on a form the dough into 1 Bake for 9-11 minutes. Allow nonstick cookie sheet. Bake for 9-11 minutes. Yields about 2 dozen cookies. to cool on a rack.
